#### TOWN OF WASHINGTON LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2019

## Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Town of Washington pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 3-c, and to allow the Town of Washington to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2020 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law Section 3-c.

#### Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of the General Municipal Law Section 3-c which expressly authorizes the town board to override the tax cap by the adoption of a local law approved by vote of sixty (60%) percent of the town board.

## Section 3. Tax levy Limit Override

The Town Board of the Town of Washington, County of Dutchess is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2020 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law Section 3-c.

## Section 4. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of this local law or its application to the person, individual, form or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

<u>Section 5.</u> This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the state's Secretary of State.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk shall file an original certified copy of this local law in the office of the Town Clerk and the required number of original certified copies in the Office of the Secretary of State, State of New York, in accordance with eh Local Law Filing Instructions published by the New York State Department of State.
