TOWN OF WASHINGTON LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2023

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Washington as follows:

Section 1. Legislation

The Town Code of the Town of Washington is amended to add a new Chapter

entitled Public Bodies – Participation by Video Technology as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>, Legislative Intent. It is the intent of this local law to give the town's public bodies as that term is defined in the Public Officers Law Section 102 the authority to participate in meetings via videoconference in a manner consistent with the town's videoconferencing policy and the authority granted in Public Officers Law Section 103-a.

Section 2. Authority. This local law is adopted pursuant to Public Officers Law Section 103-a which expressly authorizes a town board to adopt a local law giving public bodies of the town the authority to participate in meetings via videoconference from locations not accessible to the public so long as a quorum of the public body participates from locations where the public may be physically present and other conditions are met.

<u>Section 3.</u> Videoconferencing for Public Meetings. The Town Board of the Town of Washington hereby authorizes all members of the Town's public bodies to participate in meetings using videoconferencing technology in a manner consistent with Public Officers Law Section 103-a and the Town's videoconferencing policy adopted by the Town Board.

<u>Section 4.</u> Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted or adjudicated by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order of judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its

application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 2. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State.
