



Leave the Leaves - In the Right Place

- Instead of traditional bagging and sending your leaves off to the landfill, where they can contribute to methane gas, a 20X more powerful greenhouse gas than CO2, consider a leaf pile in an unused corner of your yard.
- Not only will this benefit overwintering insects, but you can also use leaves as a free mulch on garden beds, where they will slowly breakdown (when adding to a compost pile, shredding will assist with breakdown).
- For water quality purposes, make sure you don't ever leave leaves on the street this contributes to high
 phosphorous pollution in the local watershed, whereas these leaves break down naturally in your flower
 beds, compost or leaf pile.
