

**RESOLUTION D-0-1 of 2025
OF THE TOWN OF WASHINGTON
AUTHORIZING THE ROUTINE MAINTENANCE AND EMERGENCY REPAIR OF
KILLEARN ROAD**

Councilmember Joseph Rickett offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Councilmember Michael Murphy

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 165-54 of the Town of Washington Code, the Town of Washington Town Board is charged with balancing public safety with the protection of the character and aesthetic and historic features and the scenic nature of designated scenic roads; and

WHEREAS, to that end the Town of Washington Town Board is authorized to regulate alterations or improvements of roads so designated; and

WHEREAS, conditions on Killearn Road, a designated scenic road, are such that certain routine maintenance and emergency repairs are necessary in the interest of the health safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Washington and all who travel upon such road ("Alterations and Improvements"); and

WHEREAS, the Town has solicited and received recommendations from Colliers Engineering for necessary Alterations and Improvements and desires to proceed with such work; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board finds that the methodology and scope of the Alterations and Improvements have been carefully planned and can be carried out with sufficient respect and preservation of the scenic resources of Killearn Road that the interests of public safety justify, on balance, the performance of the work; and

WHEREAS, § 165-54 (G)(3) of the Town of Washington Code sets forth that where the work to be done on a scenic road is categorized as routine road maintenance

and/or emergency repairs, no public hearing is required to authorize such Alterations and Improvements;


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

1. The proposal of Colliers Engineering to perform the Alterations and Improvements is hereby accepted;
2. The Town and all its agents and officers are authorized to take such action as is necessary to see to the commencement of the Alterations and Improvements, including, as required and/or permitted by law, authorizing Town employees or agents to do such work or soliciting bids for the performance of any and all work.
