

SNOW ORDINANCE

PLEASE BE ADVISED:

As per the ***Ordinance to Regulate Parking in the Town of Washington***, resolved December 7th, 1972, please note the following:

Section 2 (b): The superintendent of Highways of the Town of Washington shall have the power to cause the immediate removal, from the right of way of any Town road or highway or of any other public property of the Town, of any vehicle which obstructs or interferes with the use of such road or highway for public travel or which interferes with the construction, reconstruction or maintenance of such road or highway; **or which obstructs or interferes with the clearing or removal of snow or ice from such road or highway during the winter season (Nov. 1 – Apr. 15)**; or which obstructs or interferes with any operation of the Town Highway Department during public emergencies.

Section 3: A violation of this ordinance is hereby declared to be an offense and a person violating the same may, upon conviction, be fined by a fine not exceeding \$50 or imprisonment not exceeding 15 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SNOW ORDINANCE
